




This newsletter highlights the dispatch statistics from the month of October 2015 and any notable and newsworthy accomplishments the system accomplished during this month.





November Status

LEAPS was dispatched a total of 360 times in the month of October to support a wide range of field operations and surveillance events. The LASD formally logged 230 LEAPS dispatches listed in the graph below.

LEAPS was architected with airborne sensors and ground-based instrumentation to augment Law Enforcement operations. The mission of LEAPS is to provide an affordable, reliable, manned, aerial surveillance system that integrates with existing Law Enforcement and/or Local Government's infrastructures.
