




This newsletter highlights the LEAPS dispatch statistics from the month of November 2015 and notable and newsworthy accomplishments the system supported during the month.



November 2015 LEAPS Dispatches Supported



November Status

LEAPS directly supported 19 arrests in November. LEAPS was dispatched a total of 317 times (87 hours of total dispatch time). Of the 317 total dispatches, LASD formally logged 202 dispatches in the month of November to support a wide range of field operations and surveillance events. Typically, if LEAPS is tasked to provide imagery for intelligence gathering or to surveil an event, the event is not logged as there is no code to assign. Examples of surveillance activities are to monitor schools/parks and to act on requests from detectives to support warrant serving, operations or verify persons or property is at a specific location. Some notable LEAPS activities this month were tracking hot burglary suspects from the scene of the crime through apprehension, air surveillance for plane crash in Leona Valley and the tracking and apprehension of a suspect leading to confiscation of a large cache of weaponry.
