LAW ENFORCEMENT AERIAL PLATFORM SYSTEM (LEAPS) PROVIDES SURVEILLANCE FOR LANCASTER WITH AERIAL OBSERVATION

During October 2016, LASD formally logged 94 LEAPS service calls where tactical field operations were supported. LEAPS was deployed 146 times for a total of 36.5 hours and was airborne and available for 325.5 hours during October.

LEAPS provided airborne observation and identification for the recovery of a stolen vehicle. LEAPS provided surveillance, search and observations assistance for the SGT Owen Suspect. Provided aerial observation and awareness supporting three containments.

Increased training and proficiency with LEAPS operations accomplished in October resulted in an increase in arrests. surveillance events and deployments and increased the LASD Lancaster Stations protection of the Community.
