LAW ENFORCEMENT AERIAL PLATFORM SYSTEM (LEAPS) PROVIDES SURVEILLANCE FOR LANCASTER WITH AERIAL OBSERVATION

During December 2016, LASD formally logged 47 LEAPS service calls where tactical field operations were supported. LEAPS was dispatched 91 times for a total of 24.9 hours and was airborne and available for 279.6 hours during December.

LEAPS provided airborne observation and support in the arrest of 19 suspects. Surveillance provided assistance in the recovery of one stolen vehicles. LEAPS provided aerial observation and awareness supporting two Narco Team containments.

Increased utilization with LEAPS operations was accomplished in December and resulted in additional arrests, surveillance events and raised the LASD Lancaster Station's protection of the Community. 0
