LAW ENFORCEMENT AERIAL PLATFORM SYSTEM (LEAPS) PROVIDES AERIAL OBSERVATION SURVEILLANCE FOR THE CITY OF LANCASTER AND THE LASD

During April 2018, LASD formally logged 134 LEAPS service calls where tactical field operations were supported. LEAPS was dispatched 117 times totaling 40.4 hours and was airborne and available for 314.6 hours.

LEAPS provided airborne observation and support in the arrest of 16 suspects. Notable assists during the month of April included aerial surveillance and support of the 2018 California Poppy Festival. LEAPS also assisted station units with the take-down of several occupied vehicles believed to have been involved in recent residential burglaries.

LEAPS provided deputies with the location of two car theft suspects who had abandoned a stolen car after a vehicle pursuit and fled on foot into a residence several streets away. Aerial assistance was also utilized in the search for a murder/suicide vehicle and the subsequent locating of the victim and suspect.
