"EYES ON THE EVENT IN 5 SECONDS"



During October 2021, LEAPS was airborne 50.8 hours and dispatched 131 times for 14.5 hours of airborne tactical support and 36.3 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for this month fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue A to the North, 185th on the East, Ave N on the South and 70th to the West; encompassing 370 square miles. Some specific events during very smoky conditions include the following:

This month saw several dirt bike and motorcycle incidents including response to the report of 20 - 30 dirt bikes running in streets, LEAPS01 followed the lawless activity for 20 minutes and directed Deputies.



LEAPS01 was dispatched to find and track a burglary suspect following the individual as he crossed backyard block walls and directed Deputies to the location and subsequent detention.

LEAPS was dispatched during an Antelope Valley High School football game in responses to a call concerning 40 -50 individuals involved in a potential fight in the stadium stands.



During the criminal Justice Center presentation, LASD noted the support provided by LEAPS and that additional support would be a big help.

During this period, LEAPS01 completed a 100 hour mandated inspection and only required the replacement of one tire.

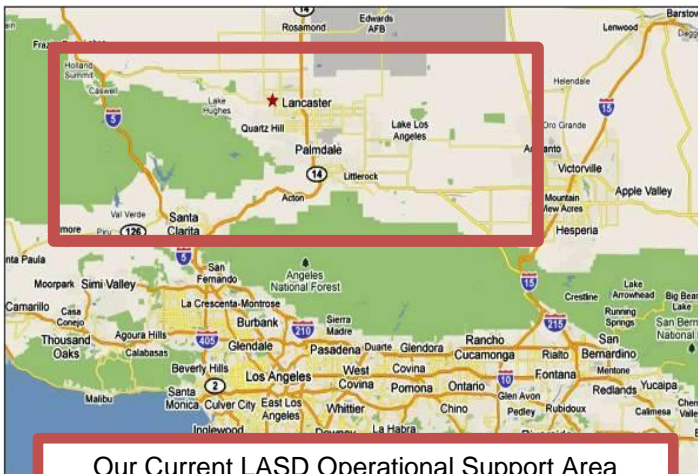
