During October 2021, LEAPS was airborne 39.4 hours and dispatched 96 times for 12.3 hours of airborne tactical support and 27.1 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for this month fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue G to the North, 55th on the East, Ave M on the South and 70th to the West; encompassing 88 square miles. Some specific events during very smoky conditions include the following:

This month saw a dispatch for a fire on the East Side of Lancaster involving a vehicle. LEAPS remained on station at the transient motorhome with the LAFD arriving and resolving the incident.



Based on a reported Global Positioning System (GPS) location, LEAPS was dispatched to provide stealthy surveillance of a stolen parked pickup truck until Deputies could arrive and investigate the vehicle.

LEAPS was dispatched during this period in response to a call of a person possibly with a gun. It remained on station until Deputies arrived and provided them aerial coverage with the detaining of three individuals



During the Criminal Justice Commission LASD Lancaster Station presentation, LASD noted the support provided by LEAPS and that additional support would be a big help.

During this period, LEAPS completed a 50 hour mandated inspection with no major repairs or replacements

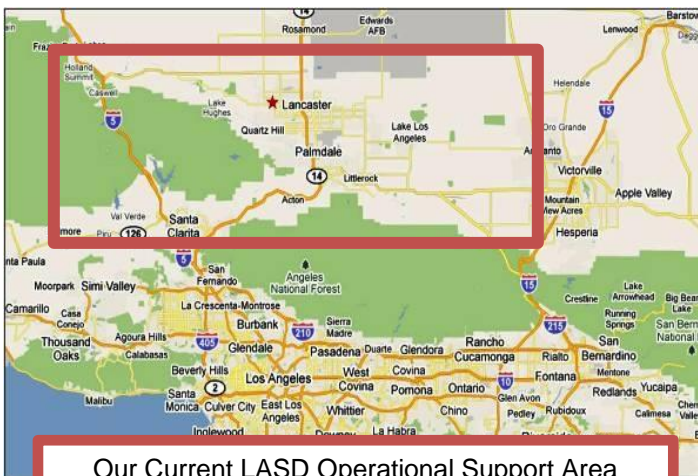
