(LEAPS)

PROVIDES AERIAL TACTICAL AND STRATEGIC RECONNAISSANCE FOR THE CITY OF LANCASTER AND THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S **DEPARTMENT**

During October 2021, LEAPS was airborne 39.4 hours and dispatched 96 times for 12.3 hours of airborne tactical support and 27.1 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for this month fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue G to the North, 55th on the East, Ave M on the South and 70th to the West; encompassing 88 square miles.
