During March 2022, LEAPS was airborne 65.2 hours and dispatched 127 times for 22.5 hours of airborne tactical support and 42.7 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for this month fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue E to the North, 190th Street on the East, Avenue P on the South and 133rd Street to the West; encompassing over 212 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

This month's dispatches included LEAPS supporting Deputies by tracking a stolen vehicle suspect and maintaining an aerial view of the situation for the Deputies capturing video of their resulting detainment.



LEAPS in response to a 911 resulting dispatch, searched for and located female teen runaway walking in the desert.

Responding to a dispatch concerning a two (2) vehicle collision, LEAPS located the incident and remained on station until Deputies brought the situation under control.



In response to support provided to and the request from LASD, LEAPS increased scheduled support by two (2) days each week.

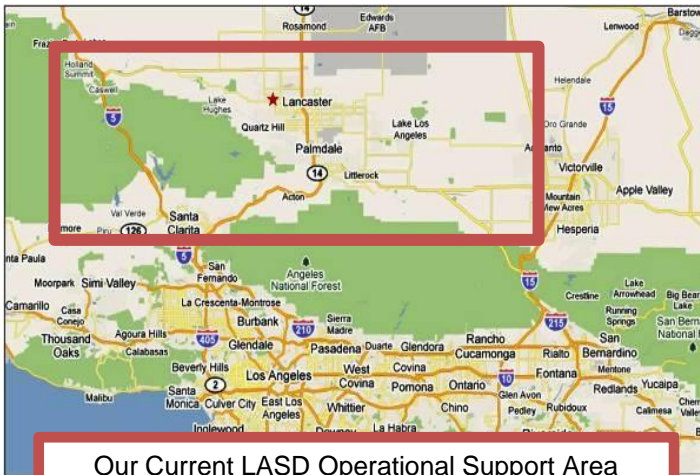
