During April 2022, LEAPS was airborne 84.8 hours and dispatched 154 times for 30.4 hours of airborne tactical support and 54.4 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for April fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue A to the North, 140th Street on the East, Avenue N on the South and 90rd Street to the West; encompassing over 345 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

April's dispatches had LEAPS supporting the Lancaster Station and Aero Deputies by tracking / positioning a suspect with a gun and maintaining an aerial view of the situation capturing video of the helo flushing and Deputies' resulting detainment of the suspect.



LEAPS responded to a 911 call reporting a fire in a desert preserve that resulted in locating a wooden bridge burning and observing until emergency response arrived.

Responding to a 911 dispatch concerning a suspect with a weapon, LEAPS provided tracking, monitoring and aerial video capture for responding Deputies.



LEAPS provided support to the City's 2022 Poppy Festival at its new venue, the Antelope Valley Fair Grounds April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>.
