During May 2022, LEAPS was airborne 59.7 hours and dispatched 124 times for 21.8 hours of airborne tactical support and 37.9 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for May fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue B to the North, 159th Street on the East, Avenue N on the South and 95th Street to the West; encompassing over 325 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

May's dispatches had LEAPS supporting and responding to a possible drug overdose. LEAPS arrived before LASD and Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) Paramedics and remained on station providing aerial video coverage,



LEAPS responded to a foot pursuit request for support concerning an indecent exposure suspect and remained covering the incident until detention was accomplished.

Responding to a 911 dispatch concerning a missing child, LEAPS located the child and awaited / notified responding Deputies.

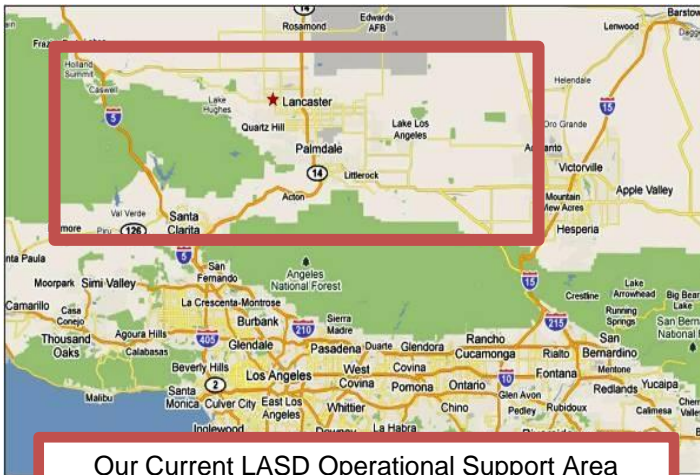
