During June 2022, LEAPS was airborne 80.4 hours and dispatched 131 times for 31.6 hours of airborne tactical support and 48.8 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for June fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue F to the North, 165th Street on the East, Avenue M on the South and 80th Street to the West; encompassing over 196 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

**PROVIDES AERIAL TACTICAL AND STRATEGIC RECONNAISSANCE FOR THE CITY OF LANCASTER** AND THE **LOS ANGELES** COUNTY SHERIFF'S **DEPARTMENT** 

June's dispatches had LEAPS supporting and responding to a reported supermarket LEAPS arrived before LASD and Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) and remained on station providing aerial video coverage,



**LEAPS** arrived first while responding to a dispatch for a FedEx driver shot by individual. Driver could identify where he was at initially. **LEAPS** located remained covering the incident until detention was accomplished.



LEAPS responded to a domestic disturbance call / man with a gun. Suspect was threatening girlfriend with a gun and male was still at the house parked in driveway. LEAPS arriving first, located the vehicle in the driveway with driver's side door open. Suspect got out of vehicle, guickly walked toward front door and then a minute later walked back to car. LEAPS relayed this to responding deputies, for their safety, who arrived, and detained suspect.
