During August 2022, LEAPS was airborne 97.6 hours and dispatched 161 times for 30.7 hours of airborne tactical support and 66.9 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for August fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue D to the North, 90th Street on the East, Avenue R-8 on the South and 60th Street to the West; encompassing over 233 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

August's dispatches had LEAPS supporting and responding to a reported call of assault with a deadly weapon that resulted in detaining the suspect at gunpoint. LEAPS circled and provided video coverage.





LEAPS arrived first and provided aerial coverage for Deputies responding to a stolen vehicle report resulting in the suspect being detained and arrested.

LEAPS responded to two (2) multiple vehicle accidents at Lancaster Boulevard and Sierra Highway on the same sortie at the end of the day. LEAPS stayed on the event for over thirty minutes and until the blocked intersection cleared was and reopened.
