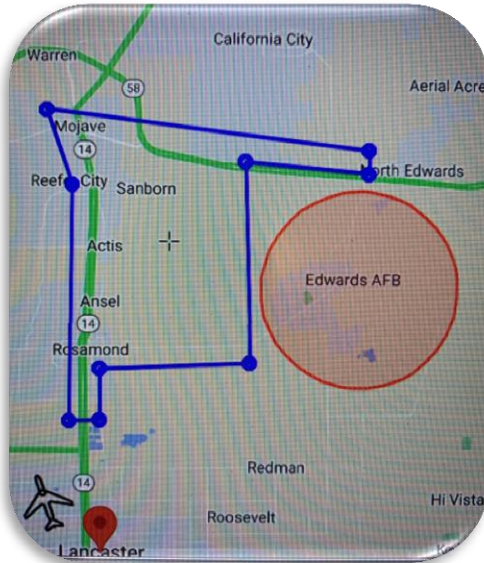
"EYES ON THE EVENT IN 5 SECONDS"



During October 2022, LEAPS was airborne 107.3 hours and dispatched 189 times for 42.1 hours of airborne tactical support and 65.2 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

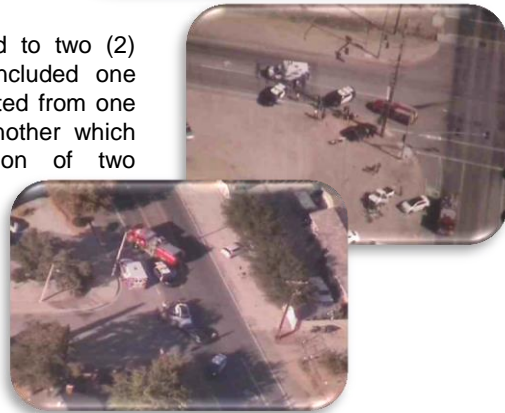
Dispatch results for October fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue E to the North, 171st Street on the East, Avenue N on the South and 90th Street to the West; encompassing over 320 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

October's dispatches also included LEAPS support to the Air Force Test Center Air Show at Edwards Air Force Base on 15 and 16 October. Tactical airborne support was provided from the Show's command post utilizing a laptop computer. In addition to the way points in the picture to the right, LEAPS also flew in the R2515 and FAA declared Temporary Flight Restriction areas over the main base at ~4500 feet. An observer from March AFB was also there in preparation for its air show.



LEAPS was dispatched to two (2) traffic collisions that included one where a child was ejected from one of the vehicles and another which was head on collision of two vehicles.

LEAPS stayed on site providing coverage until emergency first responders arrived and aided the injured.

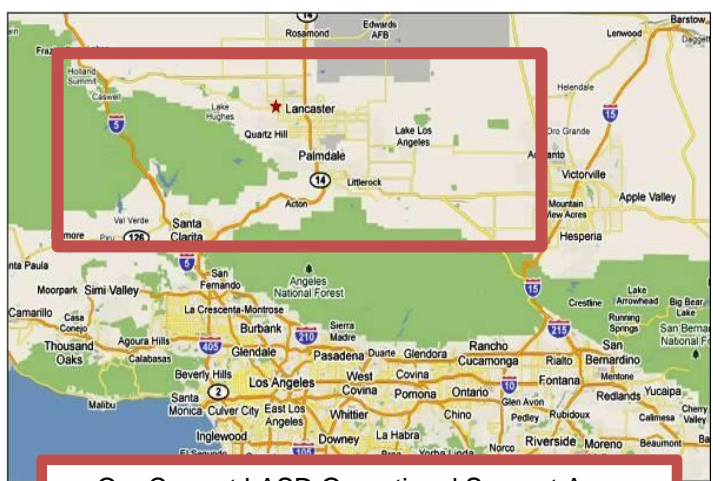
