During November 2022, LEAPS was airborne 80.8 hours and dispatched 138 times for 42.1 hours of airborne tactical support and 25.6 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for November fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue G to the North, 140th Street on the East, Avenue M on the South and 65th Street to the West; encompassing over 164 square miles. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

November's dispatches included LEAPS support for several calls of suspect with a gun.

LEAPS remained on scene until Deputies arrived and awaited their report of the call terminating.

LEAPS was dispatched to several traffic collisions. Two that involved rollovers and two that included multiple vehicles.

LEAPS remained on station until emergency responders arrived or was dispatched to another event.

LEAPS stayed on site providing coverage for a house on fire awaiting LA Fire arrival and event conclusion.

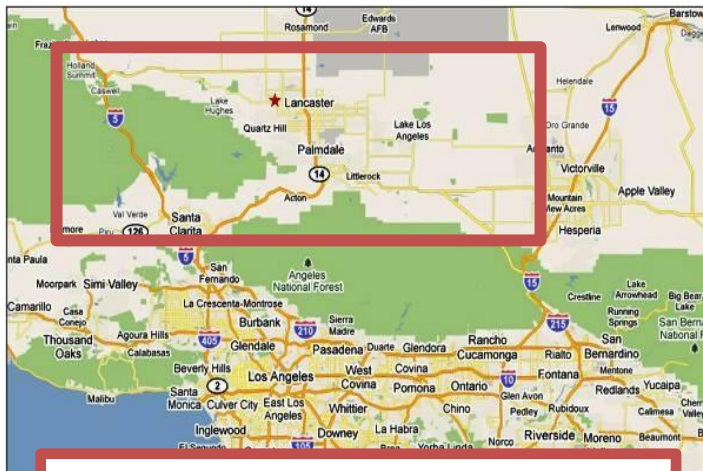
