During December 2022, LEAPS was airborne 77.5 hours and dispatched 116 times for 22.2 hours of airborne tactical support and 55.3 hours of strategic surveillance with real-time visible and infrared (IR) imagery within the Lancaster and surrounding unincorporated areas in the Antelope Valley Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) area of responsibility.

Dispatch results for December fall into distinct categories summarized to the right on this page. Dispatches from the Lancaster LASD station covered an area generally defined by Avenue A and Rosemond to the North, 103rd Street on the East, Avenue T-2 on the South and 110th Street to the West; encompassing over 426 square miles. During December we lost 35 hours of support due to climatic and windy conditions. Some specific events during windy and intermittent precipitation conditions include the following:

December's dispatches included LEAPS support for calls of suspect with a gun and remained on scene until Deputies arrived and awaited their report of the call terminating.

LEAPS was dispatched to several traffic collision calls including rollovers as well as a semi and multiple vehicles. LEAPS remained on station awaiting emergency responders arrival or was dispatched to another event.

LEAPS responded to a motorhome fire on 35th Street East and stayed on site providing coverage and awaited LA Fire arrival and event conclusion.

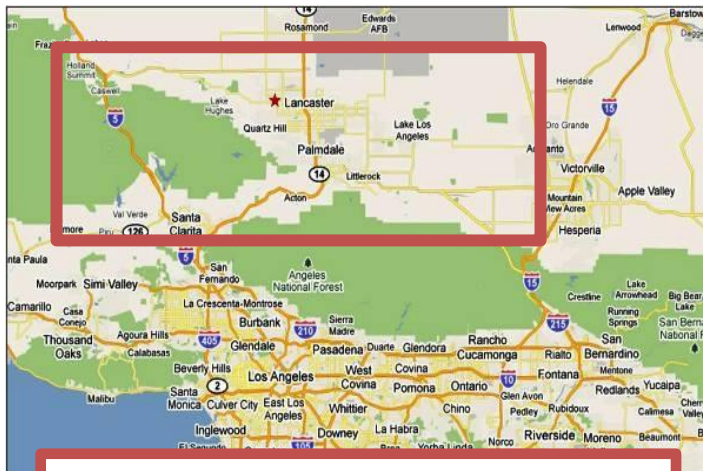
